Voluntary Product Accessibility Template (VPAT)

IP Office Web Manager is a browser-based administrative interface for IP Office systems.

It has been Avaya's experience that the vast majority of operations performed by IP Office system administrators are in a category commonly referred to as "MAC" tasks: Moves, Adds , and Changes. The statements of conformance in this document are limited to MAC operations, specifically the "add / edit / delete user" and "import user / bulk import" functions. The statements may not be applicable to other Web Manager functions. Please note also that the statements are applicable to the Mozilla Firefox and Google Chrome browsers, and might not be accurate if Web Manager is accessed via other browsers.
